What would you do if you heard the words, "Your child has cancer" or "Your child has a chronic blood disorder"? More than 320 local families have received that devastating news within the last five years. The shock and fear that comes with a diagnosis is often coupled with a sense of isolation. Parents may ask, "How do I handle this overwhelming process?" "What will happen to my child?" "Who can I turn to for support?"

CURE Childhood Cancer Association was founded by parents who navigated this journey and did not want others to face it alone. For more than 40 years, CURE has provided guidance and comfort to families through the most difficult time in their lives – families like the Spuck family.

"Being told your child has cancer is one of the hardest things a family can go through. CURE was there every step of the way to help in any way we needed. They were truly a God-send. They were the first people we met that went through this journey and were so encouraging throughout every treatment. Someone always stopped by every time we were impatient and they covered all of our parking and offered food vouchers." – Brie, a CURE mom

That kind of support is only possible because of the generosity of people like you. In 2018, the love of our community helped CURE:

- Make nearly **2,300** visits to families in the hospital. Our Parent Advocates – who have navigated their own children's cancer diagnoses – provide emotional support to parents whose children are undergoing treatment;
- Pay for more than **7,770** parking passes, so parents can attend appointments and stay by their children's bedsides without the stress of parking fees;
- Provide more than **\$18,000** in financial support to families, including assistance with utility bills, rent, household items, and funeral expenses.

A growing number of families are undergoing these difficult journeys, and CURE needs your help to alleviate the stress and financial burdens they face.
